



HOW TO STOP SCREEN JUMPING

If your screen jumps or flickers while scrolling or entering data in K360 (Cut & Dry), it's likely caused by your browser's zoom level being set too high. Reducing your zoom level to 80% helps stabilize the display and eliminates the "jumping" effect.

Steps to Fix the Screen Jumping

- Open K360 in your web browser (Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge recommended).
- On your keyboard, press: Ctrl + 0 to reset zoom to default (100%), then press Ctrl + (minus) twice to reduce to about 80%.
- Or, adjust manually: Click the three dots (:) in the top-right corner of your browser, find the "Zoom" setting, and select or type in 80%.
- Press Ctrl + R (or click refresh) to reload the page and apply your new zoom setting.

Pro Tip

If you're on a laptop or smaller monitor, 80% gives a great balance between readability and smooth performance. Users on larger screens may prefer 85–90%, but avoid going above 100% to prevent screen movement.

Why This Works

K360 uses dynamic, data-heavy pages. When your browser zoom is above 100%, it has to constantly re-render layout elements — causing flickering or "jumping." Lowering to 80% reduces redraw frequency, stabilizing the display.
