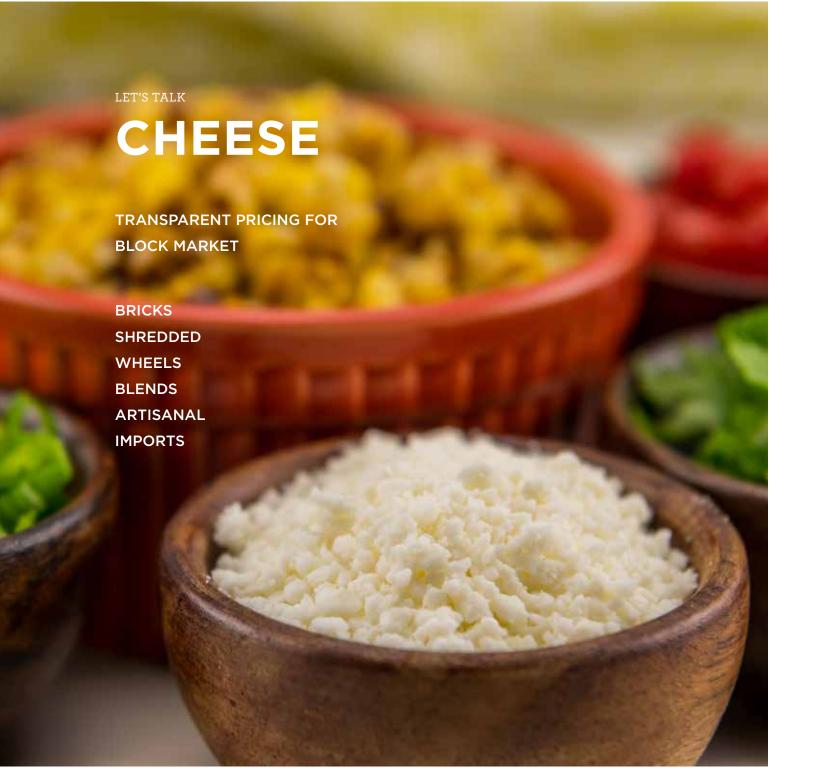












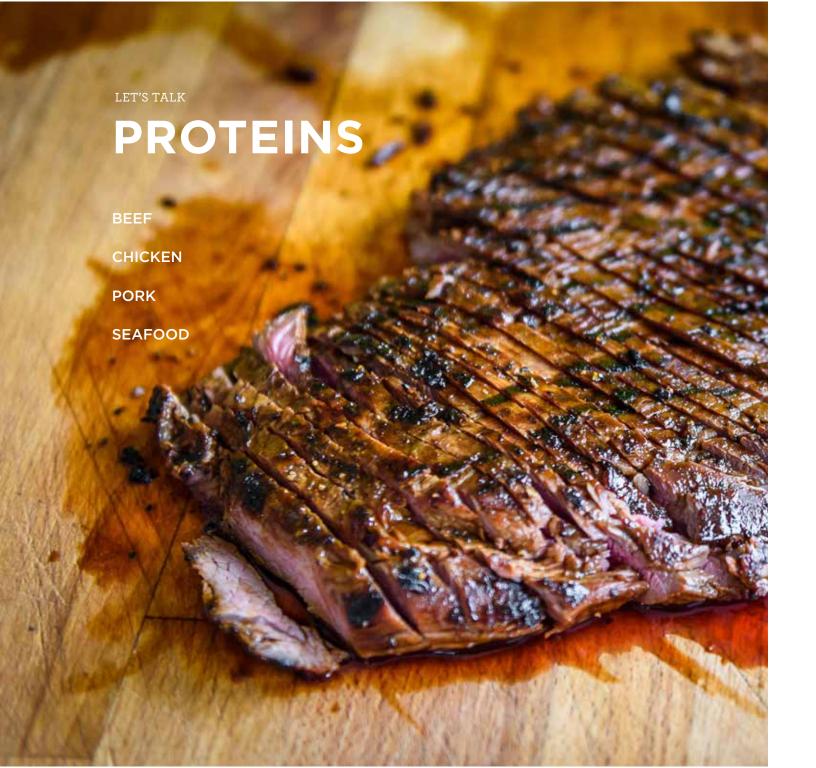

## LAMB

While not exclusive to Latin Cuisine, lamb is prominent throughout our countries, and it seems every Hispanic chef has their own proprietary method of working with it. I like to use it for traditional Barbacoa, but I've seen it all from Carnitas to Pastor. We have various cuts, including bone-in and bone-out, for everything from soups to smoking.

#### **SQUASH BLOSSOMS**

The exclusivity equivalent of Foie Gras, few products are more closely associated to Latin cuisine than squash blossoms. For those lucky enough to get their hands on them due to their short season and high demand, the dishes that come from these delicacies are often memorable. Whether it's quesadillas, soups, or stuffed and fried, quality and freshness of the blossoms are important. We make sure the blossoms you order are picked and delivered as quickly, locally, and as fresh as if you picked them yourself.



#### **EPAZOTE**

Few flavors fire off those nostalgic triggers in the brain like epazote. Another herb that is available year round through our Charlies Produce partnership, epazote adds that flavor profile to almost any dish that will leave your guests wondering how you made it! While usually used to season frijoles, try using it to freshen up a salad, sauce, or even a braise and see how it changes the complexity of the dish!



#### **LINGUICA**

When it comes to sausages in Latin cuisine, we're somewhat limited in our options, aren't we? I suppose that's why we had to steal one from Portugal! While similar to chorizo, it varies in both it's heat and density. I use it to substitute wherever chorizo is present, such as nachos, soups, or brunch items. Rolled into 4 ounce sausages, the applications are vast, depending only on how far you're willing to take it!



#### **HONEYCOMB TRIPE**

I'll admit that Honeycomb tripe isn't for everyone. If you didn't grow up eating menudo, the visual shock alone can be overwhelming. For those that do eat it, it's a lifelong loyalty, and we will go far and wide to get our fix. Our fresh tripe can be applied for all purposes, including soups, tacos, or even fried for a unique bar or happy hour appetizer. If you find yourself curious, but don't quite know how to go about it, please reach out to me and I'd be glad to help you create a menu option you'll be satisfied with.



#### **COW TONGUE**

You either grew up with it, or you didn't. Not a lot of people make the jump to all of a sudden eating cow tongue later on in life. For those who dare eat a taco de lengua, they'll be rewarded with a tasty flavor/texture combination unlike any other. At Harbor we stock fresh tongue, which won't leave that "gamey" taste that can overpower your seasoning.



#### **PEPITAS**

Often described as the "Latin sunflower seed", pepitas are the epitome of versatility. Roasted whole as a walking about snack, hulled and seasoned as a bar app, folded into desserts for a crunch, pureed for a garnish, mole, pepitas butter, bread, cookies, the possibilities of pumpkin seeds are limitless. Having minimal flavor on their own, they absorb perfectly any flavor which you are imparting. Consider pumpkin seeds as the duct tape of your culinary tool belt; they can be used for just about anything.

# POBLANO

A staple in Latin cuisine, poblano peppers are the big boy version of bell peppers. We all know to stuff them for chile relleno, but have you tried grilling, peeling, then marinating them? The heat, along with the bold flavor makes for an adult version of a pickle! Use to spice up or add more palate variety to those dishes that might need a little sprucing up. Poblanos also puree really well, making them an excellent garnish that can be added to almost any entrée.

#### **NOPALES**

Who else remembers their abuelita making nopales when you were young? Through our partnership with Charlie's Produce, we are able to offer you fresh, still rigid and thorn free (if you know, you know!) cactus by the pound. One of those rare products that is enjoyed both hot and cold, nopales is another item that I think is far too underutilized and sure to give your guests a memorable experience.



#### **OCTOPUS**

Whether your preference is fresh or pre-cooked, we have multiple options sure to fit your needs. We stock both large and small raw Spanish Octo's, perfect for Ceviche's and Campechana's, as well as Pre-cooked tentacles, excellent for grilling and sautés. If you find yourself intimidated by cooking from raw (like I do sometimes), our pre-cooked octopus tentacles which come in two sizes, are something I would be proud to serve in my restaurant.
