CARPINITO BROTHERS

Brothers Mike and Dan Carpinito started farming in the Green River Valley in their teens. Now, their sons are helping to keep the farm flourishing. They grew and sold pumpkins directly to stores and wholesalers in high school.

As one of the foremost Seattle-area growers, Carpinito constantly changes its crop rotations to adapt to local food trends. Their unique land has a deep history, including old growth covered by glacial runoff, which benefits their soil fertility.

Today, they grow over 40 different commodities on 800 acres in Kent, making them one of the largest growing operations in the valley. Despite the continued pressure from urbanization, Carpinito commits to keeping the farm where it's always been.
